1-1 Submission Period

1-2 Announcements of Official Selections

31 May 2018(Official Website Posting/Individual Notification)

1-3 NAFF It Project Dates

14 – 18 July 2018

2. Eligibility and Selection Criteria

2-1 A feature-length film project (running time 60min or longer) for theatrical release.

2-2 Either a director or producer should be attached.

2-3 Any stage of production from development, pre-production, production to post-production. The project that will have completed before the time of NAFF It Project, which is 14th July 2018, shall not be accepted.

2-4 A project that is NOT fully financed.

2-5 A project that has been selected or supported by other organizations/funds may apply except when it is fully supported financially.

3. Required Materials

- Completed entry form (online submission)

3-1 Synopsis(600 words)

3-2 Treatment(max. 6pg)

3-3 Director's Statement(300 words)

3-4 Profiles of Director/Producer/Production Company(150 words for each category)

3-5 Production Schedule(as detailed as possible)

3-6 Director's previous work(s)/Footage or trailer of the project(online link)

※ All contents should be submitted in full sentences except Production Schedule.

4. Notes to Applicants

4-1 One applicant can apply several different projects. However, one submission form is for one project submission only.

4-2 Application materials should be in English, and adhere to entry character limits.

4-3 All materials submitted will be treated as confidential and will be used by Bucheon International Fantastic Film Festival(BIFAN) only. All materials of selected project can be used for festival promotions and publications.(Including web promotion)

4-4 All materials submitted will not be returned.

5. Benefits of Selected Projects

5-1 A roundtrip flight ticket and a 4-night accommodation will be offered for a director and a 4-night accommodation for a producer of each selected project.

5-2 Complimentary B.I.G badges that give a whole access to BIFAN will be offered to project representatives.

5-3 One on one business meetings will be offered during 2018 NAFF It Project.

6. Conditions for Selected Projects

6-1 For the submitted projects with Korean language, all materials should be provided in both Korean and English languages once the project gets selected.

6-2 At least one representative MUST attend all the scheduled meetings during the days of NAFF It project.(14-18 July 2018).

6-3 Project representatives cannot veto on any meetings for any reason.

(With a prior notice, meetings can be re-scheduled.)

6-4 It will not provide any kind of translation or interpretation service at any meetings. If project representatives would bring their own translator, a day pass will be given to that individual.

7-3 The completed feature films, based on the awarded projects presented to NAFF It Project 2018 shall mention in their end credits as follows: "2018 NAFF It Project Official Selection" accompanied by B.I.G logo.(The logo will be given upon request.)

7-4 Our sponsors may request written agreements to the awardees on the specific points about citation before the payment/support.
